



### FIGHT THE BITE! HELP ELIMINATE MOSQUITOS BY PRACTICING THE FOLLOWING

- Drain standing water to eliminate mosquito breeding and egg laying
- Empty flower pots, buckets, and other containers after the rain
- Treat ponds with larvicide, turn over items which may collect water
- Unclog rain gutters and flush bird baths every 2-3 days
- Remove used tires, clean and chlorinate swimming pools
- Empty pools of standing water. Fix leaky outdoor faucets
- Fix damaged window and door screens
- Apply insect repellants with DEET, Picaridin, or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus
- Limit times outdoors between dusk and dawn
- Encourage your neighbors to do the same
