Mayor Duncan called the meeting to order. Toby Swager offered prayer. Mayor Duncan led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

City Recorder Allison Baker called the roll: Mayor Duncan present, Vice Mayor Tinnin present, Commissioner Anderson present, Commissioner Bell present, and Commissioner Young present.

Consider minutes of the January 10, 2019 regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Bell made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion and motion passed 5-0.

No citizen Comments.

City Manager Tim Ellis recognized State Senator Ferrell Haile of our Sumner County portion of Goodlettsville. Senator Haile asked to make a special presentation and City Manager Ellis welcomed him to the stage. Senator Haile recognized former Mayor, John Coombs, stating Goodlettsville was served by a gracious man. He acknowledged and was thankful for his honesty and sincerity welcoming him into the political world. Senator Haile invited Mayor Coombs family to join him on stage. He recognized the family and community's tremendous loss. Senator Hail presented Mrs. Linda Coombs with State Senate Joint Resolution 796, a resolution to honor the memory of Mayor Johns Coombs of Goodlettsville. Sponsored by Senator Dickerson and Senator Haile, adopted April 2018.

Mayor Duncan thanked Senator Haile for the presentation and recognized Mayor Coombs as a wonderful asset to the City of Goodlettsville. Mayor Duncan stated John Coombs was a great leader of his family, of his church and we still miss him to this day.

Consider old business.

Consider Ordinance 19-929, an ordinance amending the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 16, Chapter 1, Section 112 by deleting Section 112 in its entirety and replacing it with a new Section 112 as it relates to Street Specifications, second reading. Commissioner Young made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-929. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-929.

Consider Ordinance 19-930, an ordinance to amend the fiscal year 2018-2019 budget, second reading. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-930. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Mayor Duncan commended the effort put forth by the Tourism and Visitor

Bureau to acquire grant money as it is very beneficial for our City. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-930.

New Business.

Consider Resolution 19-835, a resolution ratifying membership and appointments to the City of Goodlettsville Board of Zoning and Sign Appeals. Mayor Duncan stated the board has a vacancy, as well as an opening available March 6, 2019. Nominees for the openings are Cisco Gilmore and Brian Rager. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve Resolution 19-835. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Resolution 19-835.

With no further business, Commissioner Young made a motion to adjourn. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:42 p.m. with a 5-0 vote.
