Mayor Duncan called the meeting to order. Bart Williams offered prayer. Mayor Duncan led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

City Recorder Allison Baker called the roll: Mayor Duncan present, Vice Mayor Tinnin present, Commissioner Anderson absent, Commissioner Bell present, and Commissioner Young present.

Consider minutes of the May 9, 2019 regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion and motion passed 4-0.

City Manager Tim Ellis announced that Pleasant Green Pool will open for the summer on Saturday and will open each day at 10:00am, Music on Main will begin June 6th on the City Hall lawn, and the Farmer's Market will continue each Thursday from 3:00-7:00pm at the Visitor's Center.

Commissioner Jimmy D. Anderson arrives and takes his seat among the Commissioners.

Consider old business.

Consider Ordinance 19-938, an ordinance of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee adopting the annual budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020, second reading and public hearing. No one spoke in favor or against the proposed budget. The public hearing was declared closed. Commissioner Young made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-938. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion. Mayor Duncan thanked the staff for their hard work on the budget this year. He stated they have been very diligent. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-938.

Consider new business.

Consider Ordinance 19-939, an ordinance to amend sections and subsections of the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 18, Chapter 3, as it relates to Stormwater Management, first reading. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-939. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-939.

Consider Resolution 19-851, a resolution approving an application for a Multi-Modal Transportation Access Grant from the Tennessee Department of Transportation. Vice Mayor

Tinnin made a motion to consider Resolution 19-851. Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Resolution 19-851.

With no further business, Commissioner Young made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:38 p.m. with a 5-0 vote.
