Mayor Duncan called the meeting to order. City Manager Tim Ellis offered prayer. Mayor Duncan led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

Assistant City Manager Julie High called the roll: Mayor Duncan present, Vice Mayor Tinnin absent, Commissioner Anderson present, Commissioner Bell present, and Commissioner Young present.

Consider minutes of the July 11, 2019 regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion and motion passed 4-0.

Mayor Duncan congratulated City Manager Tim Ellis on his anniversary.

Consider old business.

Consider Ordinance 19-943, an ordinance to amend the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 7, Chapter 3 by deleting Chapter 3 in its entirety and replacing it with a new Chapter 3, as it relates to Fire Services, second reading. Commissioner Bell made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-943. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-943.

Consider new business.

Consider Ordinance 19-944, an ordinance to amend the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 3, Chapter 4 by deleting Section 402 in its entirety as it relates to Electronic Citation Regulation and Fines, first reading. City Manager Ellis stated, for those watching online, that this would remove the five (5) year sunset clause of the ordinance. Commissioner Young made a motion to consider Ordinance 19-944. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve Resolution 19-856.

Consider Ordinance 19-945, an ordinance to amend the City of Goodlettsville Municipal Code Title 15, by creating a new Chapter 9, as it relates to shareable dockless mobility devices, first reading. Prohibiting the use of mobile scooters within the City Limits of Goodlettsville. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve Ordinance 19-945. Commissioner Bell seconded the motion. Vote was taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve Ordinance 19-945.

Consider Resolution 19-857, a resolution to support the adoption of federal legislation during the 116th Session of the United States Congress known as “The Safe Freight Act of 2019” or House Resolution 1748 and calling for the Tennessee General Assembly to also support said legislation. Commissioner Anderson made a motion to approve Resolution 19-857. Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Commissioner Young questioned if this would get forwarded to our Congressional Delegation. City Manager Ellis stated, traditionally, we draft a letter under the Mayor’s signature to our four members of delegation. We would send it with this resolution and the unanimous vote to support. With no further clarification or discussion, vote was taken. Resolution 19-857 passed with a 4-0 vote.

Consider Resolution 19-858, a resolution authorizing the City Attorney to file any necessary appeals in regards to zoning ordinance violations. Commissioner Bell made a motion to consider Resolution 19-858. Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Vote was taken which resulted in a 4-0 vote to approve resolution 19-858.

With no further business, Commissioner Young made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:38 p.m. with a 4-0 vote.
