In consideration of the mutual benefits to be derived, the parties agree to the following:

The City of Goodlettsville's Adopt-A-Street Program will provide:

- Volunteer group procedures and safety guide
- Safety vests
- Trash bags
- Gloves
- Recognition signage (following first event) of the area being adopted
- Safety signage
- Pick-up of filled trash bags from the adopted area within three business days following completion of the event.

The Individual/Organization/Group listed above agrees to the following:

- The individual/organization/group coordinator will hold a safety meeting with all volunteers prior to each pick-up. All volunteers must read and understand the safety procedures and sign a waiver. The waiver must be returned to the City of Goodlettsville's Adopt-A-Street Program Coordinator prior to the clean-up date.

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- Indicate dates for the next four clean-up events (once each quarter):

- Volunteers must wear safety vests provided and understands that work begins after safety signage is in its proper place.
- Post caution signage at the beginning and end of the adopted street facing oncoming traffic prior to removal of debris.
- Leave the trash bags at a designated site within the adopted area.
- Suggested adoption route is 1/2 mile in length, covers both sides of the road, and length of term is a minimum of two years.
- Obtain materials and supplies at the Adopt-A-Street Program office located at 215 Cartwright St., Goodlettsville, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays and return unused materials within three days after the date of the pick-up.
- The individual/organization/group hereby acknowledges that it is aware of the potential hazard implicit in the work to be performed. The individual/organization/group shall assume all responsibility for an shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Goodlettsville, its officers, employees, heirs, agents from and against all claims, demands, actions, judgments, settlements, and damages of every nature, degree and kind (including direct, indirect, consequential, incidental, and punitive damages), for any injury to or death to any person, for the loss of or damage to any property whatsoever (including but not limited to property owned by or in the care, custody, or control of the City of Goodlettsville, its officers, employees, or agents) arising directly or indirectly from the performance of work pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding. The individual/organization/group shall provide counsel to defend the City of Goodlettsville, its officers, employees, heirs, and agents or pay the reasonable attorney's fees and court costs of the City of Goodlettsville, its officers, employees and/or agents incurred in defense of any such action.
- All participants will be at least 12 years of age and those 17 and younger must be adequately supervised by one or more adults.
