

# MOSS-WRIGHT ARBORETUM

The Moss-Wright Arboretum is a level two arboretum developed by the Goodlettsville Tree Committee working in conjunction with the City of Goodlettsville. Sixty-four (64) species of trees make-up the arboretum which was certified in June of 2020 by the Tennessee Urban Forestry Council.

The arboretum is located in Moss-Wright Park, a 147-acre park located on Caldwell Drive in Goodlettsville, TN.

Offering both developing and mature trees, this arboretum provides a great introduction to a variety of trees native to Middle Tennessee.

Each tree within the arboretum is labeled with the tree name and a QR code. Visitors are encouraged to scan the QR code with a mobile device to learn more about the tree.

The arboretum starts at the Mansker's Station Interpretive Center and follows the 2.2 mile paved walking trail around the park. Some of the trees are just a short walk off the main path but visitors are welcome to leave the path to examine the collection more closely.
